Organizing Authority

The ALEXANDRIA International Regatta 2026 is organized by the Yacht Club of Egypt in cooperation with the Egyptian Sailing & Waterski Federation.

1 Rules

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the racing rules of sailing (RRS).
 - 1.2 No national authority prescription will apply.
 - 1.3 Rule 61.1 'Informing the protested' is changed as follows: Add to rule 61.1 (a) 'The protesting boat shall inform the race committee of the boat/being protested at the finish line immediately after finish'
 - 1.4 Each competitor shall wear personal floating device (PFD) properly always secured while on the water except when temporarily adding or removing clothing. This changes rule 40.
 - 1.5 Rule changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.
 - 1.6 If there is a conflict between languages, the English language will take precedence.
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2 Advertising

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority
 - 2.2 Each boat shall be required to display its national country code on the sail.
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3 Media, cameras and electronic equipment

- 3.1 Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound and equipment or positioning equipment as specified by the organizing authority. Information from this equipment shall not be used by a boat as evidence in a hearing. This changes rule 63.6.
 - 3.2 Selected competitors may be required to attend a press conference.
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4 Eligibility

4.1 The Regatta is open to boats and competitors who comply with the World Sailing Regulation Eligibility.

4.2 The Regatta is open to boats of the following classes and quota per Arab countries member:

	Classes	Age Group
1	Optimist	Born 2011 or later
2	ILCA 4	Born 2009 or later
3	ILCA 6	Open
4	ILCA 7	Open

4.2 Competitors shall be born in the year in the age group column or later.

4.3 All sailors should bring their own sails.

4.4 Optimist sailors should bring their mast, boom and airbags.

4.5 ILCA sailors must bring their own tiller, extension, ropes and system

4.6 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form page of the Regatta, no latter than the 15th of September 2026.

4.7 In addition to the requirements of 4.6, competitors, team leaders and coaches shall deliver signed entry forms and register at the Race Office.

4.8 Applications for quota places shall be made only by email to sailing@yachtclubegypt.com or sherif.morsi@hotmail.com using the supplied registration forms.

4.9 Each athlete shall be registered as a World Sailing Sailor on the World Sailing website: www.sailing.org .

5 Entry fee

5.1 Fees are stated in US Dollar and include any local taxes except charter boat

The entry fee for Sailors	\$ 100
The entry fee for team leaders (coaches)	\$ 100
Support vessel (including one support person)	\$ 400
Boat charter fee ILCA	\$100
Boat charter fee Optimist	\$ 50
Boat damage deposit ILCA	\$ 100
Boat damage deposit optimist	\$ 100

5.2 Entry fees will only be refunded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

5.3 Charter fees are stated in USD and exclude any local taxes and insurance.

5.4 The Organizing Authority may charge an additional fee for bank charges for each individual invoice.

6 Format

6.1 The ALEXANDRIA International Regatta for all classes will be fleet racing.

6.2 The detail of the format for each Event will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

7.1 The Race Committee may change the schedule to bring forward any number of races. The Sailing Instructions will define the process for the publication of the daily race schedule, including the allocation of Events to course areas

7.2 Registration for all competitors and support persons will be online (<https://forms.gle/7eyiKVFTmAhk9SsBA>).

7.3 No warning signal will be given after 15:00 on the last racing day.

7.4 The Organizing Authority (OA) and race committee reserve the right to modify the above program according to the weather condition or unforeseen circumstances.

8 Measurements

8.1 Equipment may be scrutinized or measured by the even equipment inspector according to the measurement regulations and approved for compliance with the class rules.

8.2 In according with Racing Rules 78, competitors are responsible for maintaining their boat in according with the class rules. (For the purpose of Racing Rules 78, competitors are considered to be the owners)

8.3 Measurement inspection at random during the Regatta may be organized.

9 Sailing Instructions

9.1 The sailing instructions will be available upon registration at the race office. Other documents governing the event will be published with the Sailing Instructions.

10 Venue

10.1 The venue will be at the Yacht Club of Egypt, Alexandria Egypt. Notice of Race.

10.2 The racing areas will be in Alexandria and their approximate locations are shown in Notice of Race Addendum 1.

The locations of the racing areas may be changed by the Organizing Authority in the Sailing Instructions.

Additional racing areas may be added by the Organizing Authority in the Sailing Instructions.

11 Courses

11.1 The courses for the fleet racing will be described in the Sailing Instructions

12 Penalty System

12.1 Appendix P will apply for the fleet racing.

12.2 Decision of the international jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5

13 International Jury

13.1 An international jury will be appointed in according with RRS 91(B). Its decision will be final as provided in RSS 70.5

14 Scoring

14.1 For fleet racing at least 1 race are required to be completed to constitute a series.

14.2 There will be 12 races in the single series for optimist and ILCA.

14.3 Discards: When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total race scores.

When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of its race scores excluding the worst score.

When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of its race scores excluding the worst 2 scores

14.4 The low point system RRS Appendix A shall apply.

15 Prizes

15.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats in each event:

15.1.1 For the optimist there will be prizes for juniors born in 2015 or after.

15.1.2 For the optimist there will be prizes for the top 3 boats overall and top 3 girls.

15.1.3 For ILCA 4 there will be prizes for the top 3 boats overall and top 3 girls.

15.1.4 For ILCA 6 there will be prizes for the top 3 boats overall and top 3 girls.

15.1.5 For ILCA 7 there will be prizes for the top 3 boats overall

15.2 Perpetual Trophies will be awarded.

15.3 More prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organizing committee.

16. [NP] INSURANCE

16.1 Each competitor and team leader (coach) shall hold a valid insurance certificate showing proof of third-party

liability coverage of at least 2,000,000 euros (or equivalent) per incident.

16.2 All competitors and team leaders (coaches) are recommended to have personal accident and health insurance

that covers them while attending the event and whilst racing.

16.3 The Organizing Authority is not responsible for verifying the status or validity of certificate

17. RISK STATEMENT

17.1 Competitors and support persons participate in the event entirely at their own risk. Rule 3 of the RRS states:

“The responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.” Sailing is by

its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the

event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

17.1.1 They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event.

17.1.2 They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore.

17.1.3 They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions.

17.1.4 By participating in any race, they are satisfied that their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate.

17.1.5 The provision of a race management team, patrol boats, umpires and other officials and volunteers by the organizer does not relieve them of their own responsibilities.

17.1.6 The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.

17.1.7 It is their responsibility to familiarize themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held for the event.

18 Transportation:

18.1 will be provided by the organizing committee included the registration fees from the airport to the hotel and from the hotel to the airport (Flight Registration information should be sent max on the 1st of October 2026).

18.2 The service applicant will **bear the full cost**, and payment will be based on an **official invoice**.
